Since these requirements were not known at the time the Ag Commission decided to add this fair to the list of yearly activities/memberships, she asked the members to consider withdrawing this item from our yearly agenda. To that end, Tom moved to rescind the original motion to participate in The County Ag Fair Day due to the insurance requirements. Deb seconded. The motion carried. As an alternative for disseminating information it was suggested we speak with the Historical Society to see if they would allow the Ag Comm to add a table to their booth at the Effingham Farmers Market in order to leave out literature that would have been put out at the County Ag Fair.
- Farmers Market: Barbara told the members that a nice article had made its way into the Union Leader promoting the market. AnnMarie suggested we laminate it.
