PUBLIC COMMENT

Erik Jones asked if the newly appointed Tax Collector/Town Clerk, Deanna Amaral is interested in being voted into the office in next March, would she be running for the remainder of the term of the former person in that office, or a new 3 year term. That question will be researched. He also asked for an update on street lighting. The Board is considering waiting for the availability of LED lighting before going forward with changing lighting fixtures. The question of what lights will be turned off, if any is still in discussion. Finally, Erik asked why the members of the Conservation Commission are not individually listed on the website. The members have decided they do not want to make that information available.

SELECTMEN'S COMMENTS AND REPORTS

Selectman Eldridge attended the recent Historic District Commission meeting. He will be assisting in getting permission from DOT for signage to delineate the District.

Kingswood Youth Center will be holding a chili cook-off on August 17th. They have requested an Effingham Selectman be one of the judges. Selectman Spencer volunteered to do so.

The septic test has been performed at the transfer station and the chosen site passed the drainage test.

Additional information is necessary for the PSNH lighting audit to be complete. The electrician who installed the lighting at the Library/Town Hall will be contacted to find what fixtures were used.

Selectmen received a report from the contracted engineer hired to evaluate the pavement deficiency of the second phase of the Town House Road reconstruction project.
