Discussion on Mike Jensen building permit

The board reviewed the Site Plan Review Regulation, Section IV Scope of Review, B Exemptions.

- 1. Home Occupation/Cottage Industry is exempt from Site Plan Review if they meet all of the following conditions:
- Lot is primarily residential
- Structure must be kept primarily residential
- No Employees except for family living in house
- Restricted Public Access
- No noxious use as defined in Section 902 of the Zoning Ordinance
- Does not involve construction of new structure or expansion of existing structure
- Is not dangerous or hazardous to public safety

The change of use (gun smith) building permit was issued with a condition of approval by the planning board. The applicant met all of the exempt conditions but the board had question on:

- Whether or not anything dangerous or hazardous to public safety would be stored on site.
 - Applicant answered nothing hazardous or dangerous to public safety would be stored on site (no black powder)
- Question on public access
 - No set hours; by appointment only

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These questions were answered to the board satisfaction and there was a motion by Paul, seconded by Jory, to advise the Zoning Officer that the Planning Board reviewed the application and has considered it exempt from site plan review. All were in favor.

Steep Slopes & Logging
