The Assistant Chair commented that she and the Secretary plan to meet to draft proposed changes to the legal description intended to correct original wording that seems to conflict with the intended boundaries within the next month or so. No additional update at this time.

3) Historic Roadside Marker for the Effingham Town Hall building.

The Chair will investigate further with regards to the State funding that is available for projects such as these. No further update at this time.

4) Potential Members/Vacancies on the Commission.

Presently no response on this request for volunteers.

5) Lord's Tavern/Failure to obtain Certificate of Approval.

To date there has still been no response from the property owner of Lord's Tavern regarding the registered letter sent in June of this year. As decided in the July meeting of the Historic District Commission, the case will be turned over to the ZEO for further action.

New Business

1) 2015 Employee/Volunteer/Elected Official of the Year Award
