## **Discussion**

- 1. Proposed meeting schedule for 2018-19 budget season and moving our meetings to Wednesday evenings due to potential conflict with selectmen's meetings running past 6:30 p.m. Was decided to keep EBC meetings on Tuesdays but with later start time of 7 p.m. If main meeting room is not available, EBC will meet in the modular.
- 2. Proposed 2018-19 budget worksheets and outside agency budget request packet reviewed. With minor corrections, members agreed to use of the forms. Chm. Strauss will present to town administrator/selectmen.
- 3. At March 2018 Town Meeting, a non-binding advisory voice vote passed unanimously to request selectmen add numerical tallies of EBC and BOS votes to each warrant article (NH RSA 32:5, V-a). Chm. Strauss noted selectmen appear reluctant to do so. Members agreed it is a valid request and worth pursuing.
- 4. Eldridge agreed to talk to selectmen regarding the implementation of vote tallies on warrant articles and their adoption of a personnel policy regarding pay raises.
- 5. Chm. Strauss asked that all requests for information from selectmen's office regarding our budget work go through him to avoid confusion or duplication. He will request a budget versus actual (BVA) report prior to each of our future meetings.
- 6. Seamans announced the NHMA will present "The Basic Law of Budgeting" May 10, 6-8pm at Ossipee Town Hall. The cost is \$20 per person. She will also contact NH DRA to try to schedule a budget law workshop for August 7.
