The Regular meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM

REVIEW AND APPROVE WEEKLY MANIFEST:

Motion made by Chairman Cahalane to accept the manifest for March 23, 2021 in the amount of \$367,527.81, Selectman Fuller seconded. Roll call: Chairman Cahalane Aye, Selectman Fuller Aye, Selectman Hart Aye. All in favor

Board reviewed mail and signature folder. Announced that Town Clerk is looking for questions for candidates night. No date identified yet.

TOWN ADMINISTRATOR COMMENTS:

The office is open for appointments with the Town assessor. Have had several 91-A requests. Computer installation is still in process. Chairman Cahalane requested an additional review folder for 91-A requests and reviewed the 91-A requests sent to the office.

SELECTMEN'S COMMENTS AND REPORTS:

Selectman Hart:

Continues to work on street lights and review the cost to remove them. Selectman Fuller would like to move forward and remove them so the Town does not continue to incur the cost. Some of them may be free due to age. Need to identify which pole has which type of light.

Selectman Hart expressed some concern about the forms referenced on the website. Chairman Cahalane will follow up in the next Planning Board Meeting.

Noted that the Historic District Commission alternates need to be sworn in.

Has been contacted by Effingham Fall Cemetery for check for spring cleanup.

Selectman Fuller:

Selectman Fuller discussed concern about the UCC fees coming to Town may not occur.

Selectman Fuller followed up on the letter to the Fire Warden.

The rate for someone to clean the library was addressed.

There was discussion about the subcontractor safety manual. Selectman Hart felt it was overkill. A work session was scheduled.
N.H. Gives resulted in funds to the Historic Town Hall last year.

Chairman Cahalane:

Chairman Cahalane addressed the spring road status.
Chairman Cahalane made a presentation on the Pine River Road culvert.
Chairman Cahalane pointed out the financial health of the Town is better than ever.

Dave Strauss had comments supporting the amount and the process.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 11:05 am.


Selectmen entered a work session for the Historic Town Hall safety manual.




