Board of Selectmen's Work Session Minutes February 1, 2024

<u>Present:</u> Chairman Espie, Selectman Racine, Selectman Seamans, Bonnie Bethune of NRRA (on phone), and Administrative Assistant Pitts

Chairman Espie called the meeting to order at 11:00 am.

Selectman Racine asked Ms. Bethune about the prices of the Light Iron Transportation. Ms. Bethune explained that the vendor used by NRRA is North Country Recycling.

Selectman Seamans asked Ms. Bethune if there was any news about North Country Recycling no longer being a vendor. Ms. Bethune did not hear anything, but stated the other vendors are WTE in Massachusetts and Radius Recycling located in Concord, NH. Bethune states NRRA looks at the average rates and will come back with better options. Chairman Espie asked if Rickers in Tamworth is listed as a vendor through NRRA, Bethune stated they are not.

Ms. Bethune explained that NRRA will not get in the middle if the Town chose to use a separate company for light iron, but NRRA can not invoice or track the pick-up.

Chairman Espie asked for confirmation that since the Town does not have a contract through NRRA the Town is able to look elsewhere. Bethune confirmed.

Selectman Racine asked about the Glass Agreement through NRRA and Waste Management. Bethune explains that the glass is picked up through Waste Management and NRRA will send a crusher to the location to crush the glass and Waste Management uses it for the landfill, roads and drainpipes. NRRA prices the glass at \$45.

Ms. Bethune asked if there was any update regarding tires from an email, she received from Zoning Enforcement Officer Boyden.

The Board agreed to stay with NRRA for the glass, and to contact Ricker's for light iron pick up.

Administrative Assistant Pitts will look into D&L Disposal for Freon, and East Coast Electronics for Electronics.

The Board agreed to have Administrative Assistant Pitts sign the Glass Agreement with NRRA.

Chairman Espie made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Selectman Seamans. Motion passed (3-0).

Meeting adjourned at 12:34 pm.
